MEMBERSHIPS DEFINED:

Section 1 – Active Membership in the International qualifies the individual for active membership in the LA Chapter #42-IAAI. Furthermore, Active Membership of government, or of a governmental agency and any representative of a business or industrial concern who is actively engaged in some phase of the suppression of arson or administration of justice at the time he/she makes application shall be eligible to active membership on application provided such person possesses the other qualifications for membership in the discretion of the Membership Committee and provided such person is not less than eighteen years of age at the time he/she makes application. All applications for active or associate membership, if accepted, will be on temporary status until the next meeting of the Board of Directors. During this temporary status period, a person's membership may be revoked at the discretion of the Board of Directors. If the application is not rejected by the "Board" within the specified time limit, membership is automatically granted. This status allows this individual to hold office in the Chapter.

Section 2 – Associate Membership: Persons not qualified for active membership may become associate members, after determination of their qualifications by the Membership Committee. Associate members shall have the privileges of an active member EXCEPT holding office. The Association may by majority vote of active members present, exclude associate members from any particular business meeting.

Section 3 – Personal Qualifications: Prior to voting upon each application, the Membership shall give due consideration to the following, among other qualifications it deems applicable, to wit: (1) the personal character and reputation of the applicant; (2) the nature, character and reputation of the applicant's business; (3) the character and reputation of employer and associates; and (4) the general nature, character reputation of the principal business of the applicant's employer and associates. No person shall be eligible for any class of membership if he/she has been a member, or is presently a member, or becomes a member of a subversive organization or of any organization whose objectives and operations are inconsistent with the purposes of the Association.

Section 4 – Sustaining Membership: Individuals or organizations, or agencies who donate, contribute or provide services the amount equal to \$150.00 shall be allowed this status. They MAY NOT VOTE OR HOLD OFFICE. This is renewable on an annual basis.
